## **TRUCKEE PETS SAY THANKS**

Did you realize the Humane Society of Truckee-Tahoe has a Pet Pantry program and that the Giving Fund awarded them a grant last fall to help offset its cost?

The Pet Pantry provides pet food and products to residents of the greater Truckee area - no questions asked. Bear-proof bins stocked with supplies are located outside the shelter entrance and can be accessed during working hours.

Prior to the COVID-19 pandemic, the program operated primarily



on donations from the community. Today, it is supported by grants, and the pandemic created an exponentially greater need for this program overnight. According to CEO Stephanie Nistler, the Pet Pantry program has distributed over 10,000 pounds of pet food and cat litter since March 2020 in addition to other vital pet supplies. They obtain discounts on supplies through corporate relationships in order to provide the means to keep pets fed, healthy and at home with their owners.
